Reply to Extension Request to MDEQ Letter dated May 8, 2019

On behalf of Ford Motor Company (Ford), this memorandum has been prepared by Arcadis of Michigan, LLC for the Livonia Transmission Plant (LTP) site (the site). The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) provided comments regarding the extension request submitted by Ford on April 17, 2019. In the May 8, 2019 letter, EGLE requested additional information related to three specific properties. Detailed below is an update for the following properties 34380 Beacon, 12124 Boston Post, and 34644 Beacon.

- 34380 Beacon The design is completed and was submitted to EGLE on March 10, 2019. The interim preemptive mitigation system is currently installed and has been in operation since April 2, 2019. The system is currently in routine operation and maintenance. Post mitigation sampling is scheduled for the week of May 20, 2019.
- 12124 Boston Post The design is completed and was submitted to EGLE on March 9, 2019. This property was scheduled for the installation of the preemptive mitigation system on March 23, 2019. On March 19, 2019, Arcadis received an email from the property owner declining the installation of the preemptive mitigation system. The property owner indicated that he wanted to discuss in further detail with his attorney. On March 18, 2019, the property owner also declined the air purifier, citing that the purifier would make too much noise and take up too much space. As of May 17, 2019, Arcadis has been unable to schedule the installation of the interim preemptive mitigation system. The resident is allowing Arcadis to complete vapor intrusion sampling. Ford's outside counsel is

- communicating with the property owner's counsel in an effort to obtain access to install the interim preemptive mitigation system.
- 34644 Beacon The design is completed and was submitted to EGLE on March 1, 2019. The interim preemptive mitigation system is tentatively scheduled to begin on May 28, 2019. The property owner is only allowing construction activities to occur when they are home, which is after 4:00 PM. The property owner is also requesting a white liner instead of the black liner that is currently being used at all other locations. The property owner has also indicated that the fans on neighboring properties are too loud. Arcadis is currently working with the property owner to address their concerns and would like to schedule a pre-construction meeting prior to implementation.

Arcadis continues to work diligently to install the interim preemptive mitigation systems. Arcadis will provide a detailed update on all property locations by June 3, as requested by EGLE.
