The Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Remediation and Redevelopment Division has reviewed the "Offsite Interim Preemptive Mitigation Installation Monthly Update" submitted for the month of October 2020.

This update closes with a request from Ford to modify the schedule of Interim Preemptive Mitigation (IPM) system updates from monthly to quarterly. IPM systems were initially required by EGLE on May 26, 2019, from shallow monitoring well data. Having installed and entered an operational phase for these systems at 31 of 33 residential properties, Pursuant to Paragraph 22.1 of the CD, EGLE concurs that quarterly updates are sufficient during the continued operational phase of the IPMs. The next quarterly update should be submitted to EGLE no later than January 31, 2021 and may be submitted as part of the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2020 Quarterly Progress Report.

It is expected that Ford will continue to update EGLE on progress at the two remaining IPM installation locations and continue working to optimize, operate, and maintain all systems to EGLE's performance metrics, provide quarterly updates, and notify EGLE of significant operational changes. Should shallow monitoring well data require additional IPMs in the future, EGLE may revisit and modify the timeline for IPM updates.
