On behalf of Ford Motor Company (Ford), this memorandum (memo) has been prepared by Arcadis of Michigan, LLC (Arcadis) for the Livonia Transmission Plant (LTP) site (the site). This memo provides a response to the Michigan Department of Environmental, Great Lakes, and Energy's (EGLE) approval letter (July 20, 2023) for the Response Activity Plan for Interim Response Activities – Property Boundary Zero Valent. The response to comments outlines action items to satisfy EGLE's request in the letter.

• The performance monitoring program as proposed in Section 5 of the Response Activity Plan needs to be revised to include both the six existing wells as identified on Table 1 and the two new monitoring wells to be installed as indicated in Section 4.2 of the Response Activity Plan. Baseline monitoring and the subsequent quarterly performance monitoring must be conducted from all eight wells (six existing and two new wells) that will comprise the performance monitoring well network.

**Response:** Baseline samples will be collected from the six existing monitoring wells and the two new proposed monitoring wells prior to any injections. Post injection performance samples will be collected from all eight performance monitoring wells on a guarterly basis.

 Table 1 must be revised to identify the two new monitoring wells in the well network to be sampled to document the performance of the response activities.

Response: Table 1, which is attached, has been updated per EGLE's request.

• The title of Table 1 must also be revised to remove the words "Remedial Action" and replace them with the words "Response Activity".
